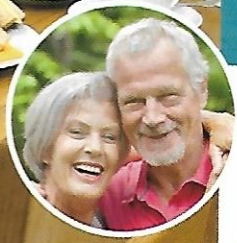

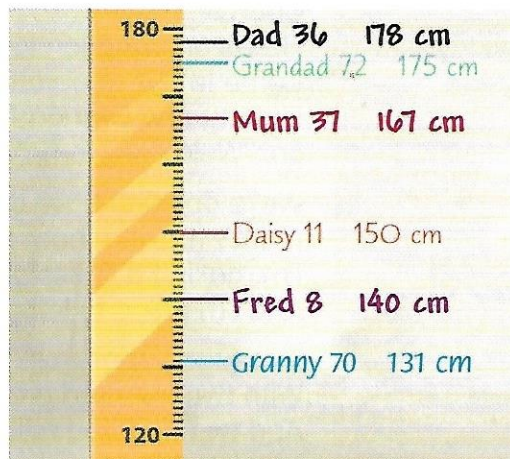

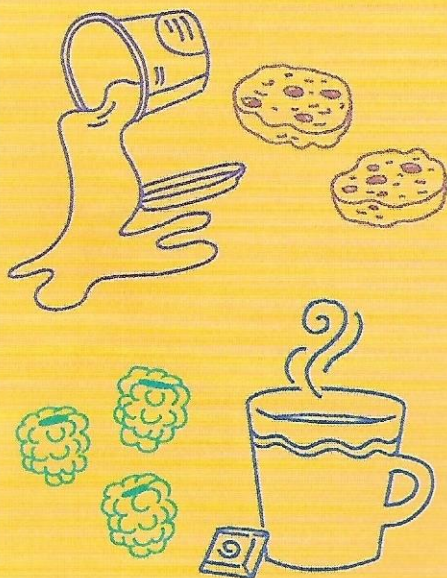

Delicious chocolate cake recipe

Ingredients:

5 tbsps butter
 300 g sugar
 200 g flour
 2 eggs
 200 ml milk
 200 ml cream
 300 g chocolate
 200 g chocolate icing
 100 g raspberries
 3 tps chocolate sprinkles

- ① Put 5 tablespoons of butter and the sugar in a bowl. Mix.
- ② Add 200 grams of flour.
- ③ Mix in 2 eggs, 200 millilitres of cream and the milk.
- ④ Melt the chocolate. Add it to the cake mixture.
- ⑤ Bake in the oven for 25 minutes at 180°C.
- ⑥ Put the chocolate icing on top of the cake.
- ⑦ Finally, put the raspberries and 3 teaspoons of chocolate sprinkles on the cake. Enjoy!

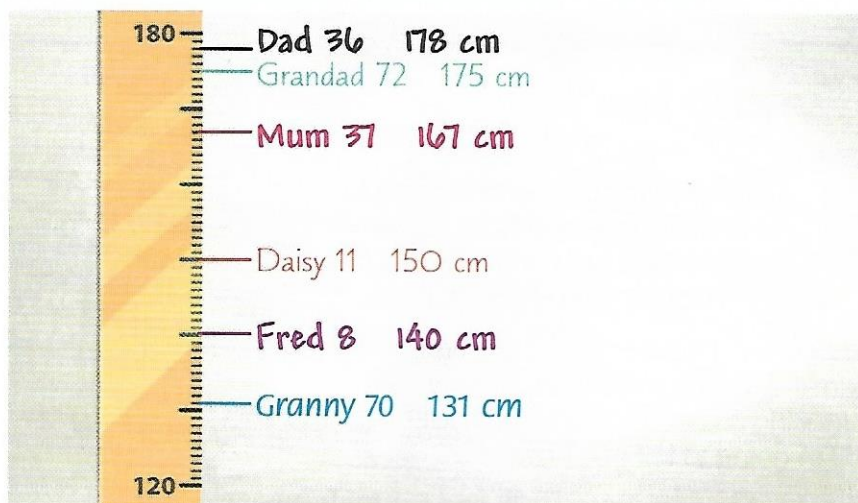



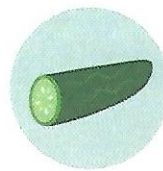
