

## Letter to Anne Frank

Dear Anne Frank

I have found out everything that happened to you years ago, when you and your family had to hide in an apartment in Amsterdam to flee Nazi persecution. You might wonder why I know all that, maybe you will remember when you turned 13 and your dad

I give a diary where you wrote your experiences and when you lived so horrible things, then your dad found it and published it and now thanks to that

You are famous and with the newspaper we can know what those difficult days were like

in which you had to be hidden so as not to be taken to a field of concentration and also for people to know about you and what you had to

pass for being Jewish and for Hitler with his obsession with having a pure race

being that of a half Jewish half German family.

You lived in very difficult times since you had to adopt certain precautions so that they cannot be seen or heard so that they are not captured

and out of everything they have certain restrictions like not using buses, they can only

enter Jewish stores, be inside the house before eight because or but they have problems and out of everything they have to use a star

yellow so that people would know that they are Jews.

After that everything got worse. In July 1942, your sister Margot They sent a letter saying that he received a notice ordering him to appear

for deportation to a work camp, for which you and your family

I had to go hide behind the office where they worked before the war

your dad, as you already know, it was a very small place and out of everything after

For a while they shared it with four other Jewish people, the situation you lived in was difficult because an extremely small place

shared with eight people and without ever leaving but luckily they have

people and friends from outside who helped them by bringing them food and things that

they will need

After 2 years hiding in such an ugly place, one morning a car arrived

a place where they hid, the secret annex as you used to call it and the German policemen arrested all eight people hiding there, someone had told the police that they were hiding in that place.

The policemen also arrested 2 people who helped them hide they were sent to prison and you first they were put in prison in Amsterdam. Then they were sent to a field consultation in Poland

Then all those who were hiding in the secret annex emerged except you, your sister and your father, you and your sister were sent to

Auschwitz to the bergen-belsen concentration camp, a terrible disease attacked the prisoners of the concertation camp, you and you

sister appeared there because of that illness, and shortly after after your death the British arrived at the concentration camp freeing those who survived.

Your father was the only one of the eight who survived, Otto Frank your father spent the rest of his life trying to share the message of your diary with the rest of the world.
