- GRAMÁTICA:

When + Simple Past.

Past Continuous.

While + Past Continuous.

Past Continuous vs Simple Past.

- VOCABULARIO:

Verbs and phrases related to greetings: *bow, wave, shake hands*; etc.

Collocations with *money*: *collect / raise money*; etc.

Vocabulary related to fundraising campaigns: *receive donations, sell food*; etc.

Vocabulary related to fundraising events: *school fair, tea party*; etc.

- GRAMÁTICA:

Present Continuous (for arrangements).

Going to (for future plans, firm intentions & predictions).

- VOCABULARIO:

Suggestions: *What about... ? / How about... ? / Let's... / Would you like to... ? / I'd love to... /*

Present Perfect vs Simple Past

- VOCABULARIO:

Verb phrases related to travelling: *eat insects, be abroad*; etc.

Verb phrases: *dye your hair, wear jeans*; etc.

Verb phrases related to after-school and summer jobs: *walk a dog, make coffee*; etc.

Verb phrases related to jobs: *look for a job, have an interview*; etc.

UNIDAD 4: TEENS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

- GRAMÁTICA:

Present Perfect (for present result of a finished action)

Past participles (revision)

Present Perfect with *already & yet*

Present Perfect with *just*

Simple Present / Simple Past / Present Perfect / Present Continuous / Past Continuous /

Simple Future

- VOCABULARIO:

Verb phrases: *tidy your room, do homework*; etc.

Verb phrases related to arguments and conflicts: *slam the door, be grounded*; etc.

Verb phrases related to life events: *graduate from school, win an award*; etc.

Newspaper sections: *science, sports*; etc.

UNIDAD 5: CHANGES IN LIFESTYLES

- **GRAMÁTICA:**

Adverbs of manner (regular & irregular): *badly, hard, happily, well, fast, comfortably*; etc.

Comparative of adverbs: *more clearly than, better than*; etc.

Superlative of adverbs: *the most clearly (of all)*; etc.

Used to + verb (aff, neg & interrog & short answers)

- **VOCABULARIO:**

Verb phrases related to teens' lives: *have proms, wear uniforms*; etc.

Vocabulary related to books: *best-seller, novel*; etc.

Vocabulary related to urban tribes: *skaters, hip-hop*; etc.

Household items: *vacuum cleaner, microwave, dishwasher*; etc.

UNIDAD 6: THE POWER OF THE MIND

- **GRAMÁTICA:**

Conditional sentences Type 1

Word categories: noun, adjective, adverb, verb, conjunction, pronoun & article

Compounds with *some*: *somebody / someone, something & somewhere*

Compounds with *any*: *anybody / anyone, anything & anywhere*

Compounds with *no*: *nobody / no one, nothing & nowhere*

Question tags (in the past, present & future)

- **VOCABULARIO:**

Verb phrases: *look on the bright side, give up*; etc.

Vocabulary related to dreaming and sleeping: *asleep, nightmare*; etc.

Verb phrases: *be chased, get lost*; etc.

Vocabulary related to dreaming: *remember dreams, vivid dreams*; etc.

UNIDAD 7: GROWING TRENDS

- **GRAMÁTICA:**

Present Perfect with *for* and *since*

How long... + Present Perfect

Comparisons: *not as... as*

Adjective + preposition + noun / *-ing*: *interested insomething, interested in doing something;*
etc.

- VOCABULARIO:

Some nouns and noun phrases: *e-waste footprint, recyclers;* etc.

Unusual jobs: *video game tester, animal chiropractor;* etc.

Adjectives used to describe jobs: *well-paid, rewarding, stressful;* etc.

Adjectives: *interested, responsible, fascinated, worried, afraid;* etc.
