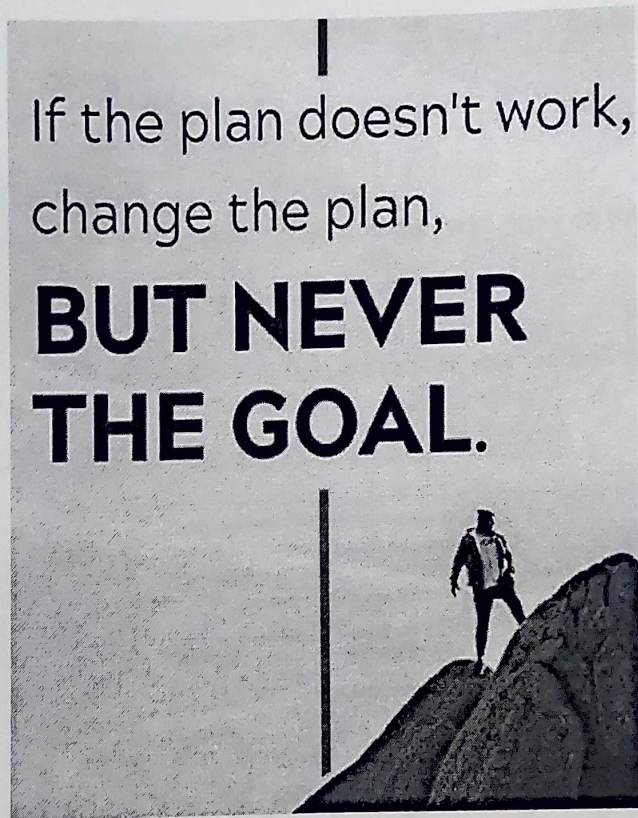
2. Answer the following questions.

Example: this is a motivational phrase that encourages us to never give up. We use in this phrase zero conditional.



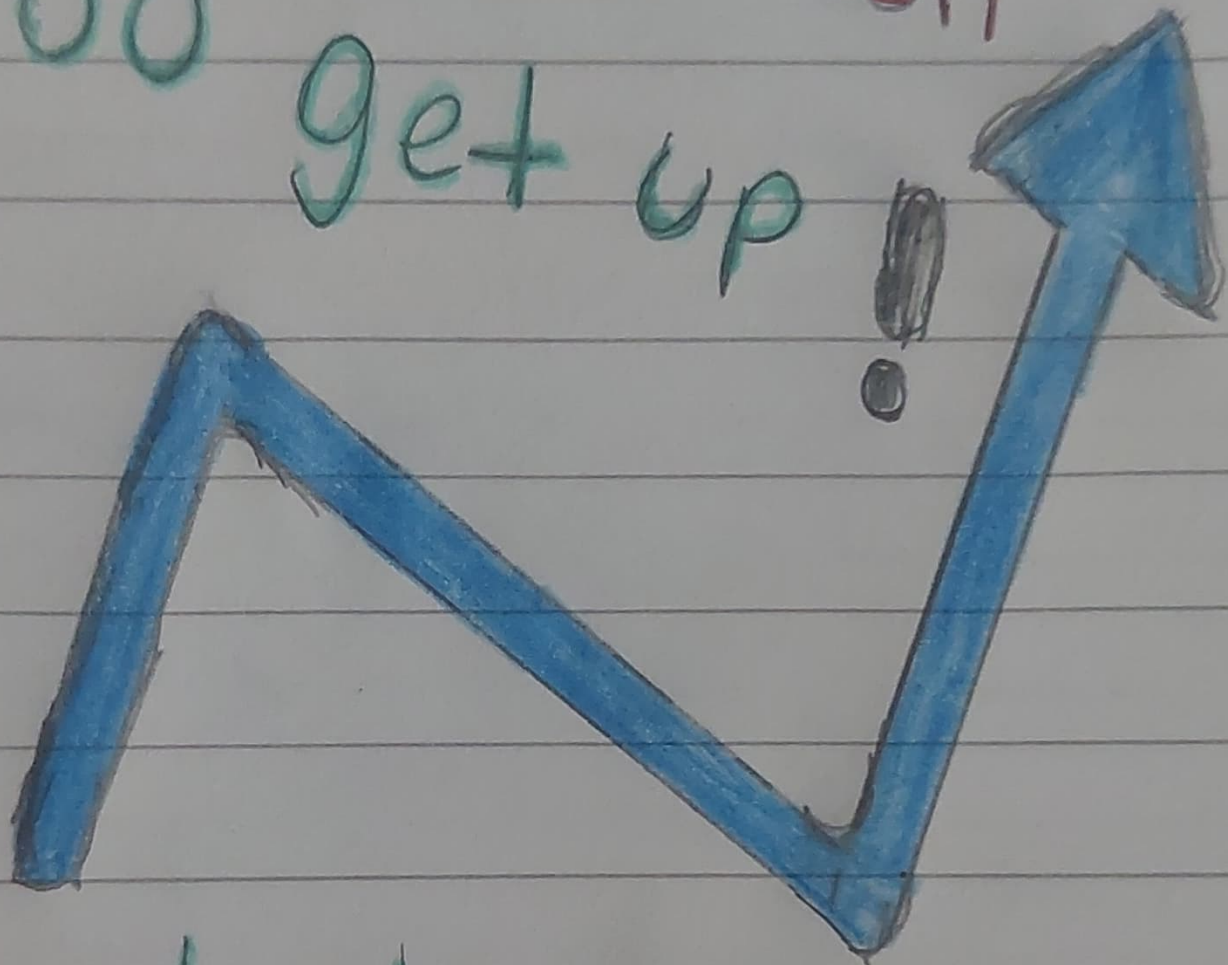
